## LOCAL RULES

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS

(A) Beyond any line of white stakes. (B) All residential properties are private and out of bounds, golf balls may NOT be retrieved even if they are visible. (C) Beyond any of the estate's boundary walls.

### 2. ROAD AND PATHS

All balls coming to rest on a defined or artificially surfaced roadway may be lifted and dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole.

### 3. FLOWER BEDS

All flower beds are to be treated as G.U.R. and relief is compulsory, within one club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole.

### 4. TREE BOWLS

A ball coming to rest in a tree bowl may be dropped within one club length from the nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole.

### 5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

All distance markers, sprinkler heads, control boxes, rain shelters, benches, dustbins, sand holders, wooden fencing, drinking fountains and other fixtures being part of the irrigation system are to be treated as immovable obstructions. Relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2B

### 6. ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVE AREAS (ESA)

The Environmentally Sensitive Areas are to be treated as a lateral water hazard and are demarcated by blue stakes. Players are prohibited from entering, retrieving or from playing from the ESA. The player must proceed as per Rule 26-1 under penalty of one stroke.

### 7. All other local rules are displayed on the notice board.

### 8. PACE OF PLAY
